# GREGOR JOHANN MENDEL

## THE FATHER OF GENETICS

### BRNO — THE CITY WHERE GENETICS WAS BORN

**Gregor Johann Mendel (1822–1884) is one of the most significant men in history, not only that of Brno.**

From 1856 he studied the cross-breeding of peas in Brno. Based on his experiments, he formulated three rules, later known as Mendel's laws of inheritance. In 1867, he became the abbot of the Abbey of St Thomas and was soon appointed to additional positions, which meant that he had to put aside his research.

Although Mendel was among the most significant citizens of Brno during his life, his contribution to biology was fully appreciated only after his death in 1884.
